# **IMPORTANT BUS RULES** (see full list in Disney packet):

- Remember, once the luggage is under the bus, you will NOT have access again until arrival to destination.
- Bus must be quiet during every attendance check. Please respond respectfully when name is called.
- Stay seated and in assigned seats.
- No trash on the bus floor, ever. Clean up any accidents immediately.
- Lights out and quiet time are not optional.
- Only 1 carryon (Bob Rogers bag optional), pillow, blanket are allowed on the bus.
- Be very smart with the amount of beverages consumed and take advantage of bathroom breaks. Unplanned stops will throw off the tour schedule. Bus bathrooms are for absolute emergencies only.

#### **IMPORTANT HOTEL RULES** (see full list in Disney packet):

- You must be quiet in your rooms. We need to be respectful to the "regular" residents and we want the opportunity for the CCHS Band to return in the future.
- All students must be visible at chaperone room checks. Once the door is closed and taped, no students may leave the room until tape is removed by a chaperone in the morning.
- No students of the opposite sex should be in your room at any point in the trip.
- Please stay off of the hotel phone lines unless there is an emergency. Use your own communication device.
