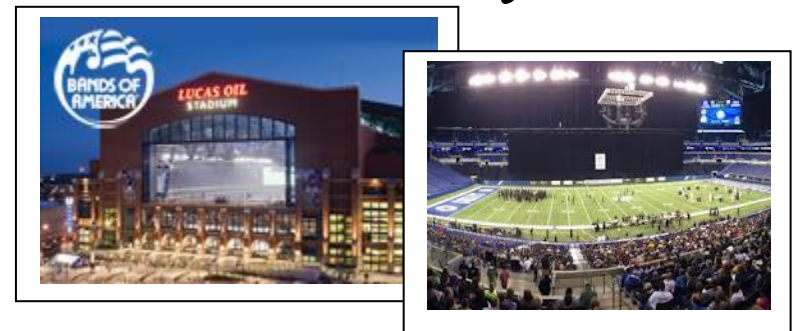
DIRECTIONS TO STADIUM FROM COLUMBUS

*****Cheer all bands*****

Cheer enthusiastically for all bands. Our performance is not diminished when we applaud others. In fact, just the opposite occurs. Other booster groups see and appreciate our response to their bands and reciprocate with their applause.

Avoid entering or exiting your seats while a band is performing. Show a friendly, helpful and enthusiastic attitude toward other fans. Boosters should be the same leaders in the stands they expect their students to be on the field, and vice versa.

Try to sit near other Central Crossing Band Boosters. A group is much easier to spot from the field and shows our band how many of us are there supporting them. (Please, try to help other Crossing Band Boosters find seats near the group, too)

PLEASE NOTE THAT NO AUDIO OR VIDEO EQUIPMENT IS ALLOWED INTO THE STADIUM

Music for All has contracted to have all of the Bands of America Championships professionally videotaped. In order to make this a viable endeavor for a professional video production company, no personal recording devices—video or audio—will be allowed into stadium. The video production company will bring to the event site professional staff and videotaping equipment, as well as production and editing equipment.

This policy also enables Music for All to comply with the United States copyright laws prohibiting the recording of copyrighted material without consent of the copyright holders. Music for All asks your assistance in making this clear to your band parents to avoid unnecessary embarrassment and misunderstandings at the event. Thank you for your understanding.

Family, friends and fans may take still photos of BOA events for personal use only. The images may not be sold or otherwise distributed, without the written permission of Music for All. Any still camera (making film or digital still pictures) is allowed into and may be used from the spectator seating area of any venue. Tripods or other similar equipment that may obstruct the view or path of travel of others in seating areas are also not allowed. Cameras (of any kind) may NOT be used on the field. (People with field passes or name badges must go into the stands to take still pictures.).
