4. Turn left onto OH-3 N/US-62 E/Harrisburg Pike 459 ft
5. Take the ramp onto I-270 E 4.0 mi
6. Take exit 52 to merge onto US-23 S/S High St/Portsmouth-Columbus Rd toward Circleville Continue to follow US-23 S 19.6 mi
7. Take the US-22/OH-56 ramp to Circleville/Washington C H 0.2 mi
8. Turn left onto OH-56 E/US-22 E/W Main St Continue to follow OH-56 E 4.7 mi
9. Slight left onto Tarlton Rd Destination will be on the right 1.8 mi
